

Casino Queen Marquette supports the State of Iowa, the City of Marquette and Clayton County



\$5,390,421 STATE GAMING TAXES, OTHER STATE TAXES & FEES

Based on revenues and admissions, as prescribed by the Iowa Racing and Gaming Commission. These taxes and fees are paid to the State General Fund. This also includes state sales taxes and state use taxes. (Represents 81.19% of the total paid)

\$219,722 UPPER MISSISSIPPI GAMING CORP. (UMGC)

UMGC, Casino Queen's license holder, is a non-profit corporation that distributes funds provided by an admissions fee paid for each patron that enters the casino. (Represents 3.31% of the total paid)

\$579,633 CITY OF MARQUETTE TAXES & FEES

The City of Marquette allocates revenues for capital improvements and other city projects. (Represents 8.73% of the total paid)

\$196,917 COUNTY ENDOWMENT FUND

These funds are paid to the state and allocated by the state to neighboring Iowa counties without casinos. (Represents 2.97% of the total paid)

\$252,576 CLAYTON COUNTY TAXES

Taxes paid to the county are utilized for a Property Relief Tax Fund that helps reduce taxes throughout Clayton County. 2017 totals included payments of property taxes of \$130,016. (Represents 3.80% of the total paid)
