**Scott County Regional Authority Awards Nearly \$1.5 Million
bringing total funding since 1991 to \$84 Million**

The Scott County Regional Authority (SCRA) announced today awards of nearly \$1.5 million for the fall 2018 grant cycle.

The Authority received a total of 96 requests for funding totaling \$2,636,013. A total of \$1,496,797 was awarded to 72 projects benefiting residents of Scott County.

This brings SCRA funding since 1991 to \$84,368,338 for the benefit of people and organizations in our community.
